When the couple joined the project, the South Hill kitchen was already gutted. The homeowners had a clear idea of what they wanted, were working with an architect designer and had their vision on paper.

The main remodeler working on the house was Lorin Ginther of Design Action Construction of Puyallup, who asked the Hylands to join the team. "We were quite flattered," Billie Jo Hyland said.

The Hylands coordinated the kitchen project. It's important for everyone to work together so the cabinets appliances, wiring, plumbing and everything else fits perfectly like a puzzle, they explained. The solid beech wood cabinets with glass inlays were built custom for the kitchen. There are his and hers sinks, as well as separate in drawer refrigerators and dishwashers, too. In view is an old world style range. The counters are granite and the raised kitchen island counter is a Peruvian walnut wood that curves.

Some people imagine how they wish their kitchen could look, but they aren't sure where to start. The Hylands have an answer. "Start with a dream," Tim Hyland said. Billie Jo added, "We try to make dreams come true. We make it not only beautiful, but functional."
